

Solutions for the oil industry

He founded RDS Austria, and has held multiple Director Positions with Rig Design Services now the Engineering arm of KCA Deutag before founding of PM Lucas.

PM Lucas is a fully integrated service provider for the oil and gas exploration and production sectors and related industries that provides complete E&P engineering solutions, from geological and geophysical, reservoir management, production, drilling and well intervention, to process and surface facility engineering.

The company's project experience includes: complete field development; well drilling and intervention; field production management; facility engineering and construction; full field turnkey development; and complete oilfield management services. It also provides single consultant specialised support to complete turnkey, along with EPC, EPSCM, EPCC and BOOM solutions. As an integrated engineering solutions provider, PM Lucas provides solutions to the industry across the complete cycle: it does not have any direct competitors.

The company's approach is very similar to Schlumberger's IPM (Integrated Project Management), combined with Petrofac's facility engineering and turnkey EPC solutions. The company combines and integrates all services into a single cycle. The target is small or medium sized projects that are too small for the big players and require integration of all services. PM Lucas has often been described as an 'oil company engineering heart', or an 'oil company without an oilfield' that provides this capability as a service. About the company in Kazakhstan

PM Lucas has been operating in Kazakhstan since 1999 as an integrated engineering service provider. Since then it has provided multiple subsurface engineering services such as geological and geophysical assessment, reservoir, production and other petroleum engineering services. In surface engineering services range from conceptual design, basic design, detailed design for the oil handling, gas handling, and water handling system and oil receiving system.

PM Lucas has drilled or managed more than 1,200 wells, equivalent to 1,000,000 metres of drilling, with

wells ranging from 500 to 5,000 metres, of which 250 wells or 300,000 metres were performed on a complete turnkey basis. In addition to this Lucas has managed more than 15,000 well interventions. Furthermore, the Company has engineered, designed, or built hundreds of kilometres of roads, flowlines, and pipelines. The company has recently developed a complete oilfield development in Kazakhstan on a turnkey basis as the general contractor. The work started with the FEED (basic design) to complete turnkey EPCC development to operations and maintenance.
